These characteristics can include economic hardship, having single or young parents, and belonging to ethnic minority groups.
- Targeted Indicated** – This applies to interventions that target a smaller percentage of the population of young people or families who have a pre-identified issue or diagnosed problem requiring more intensive support, e.g. programmes that target young people who are identified in pre-school or by parents as having behaviour problems.
